FIRST STATION

Jesus Is Condemned

SECOND STATION

Prayer: Lord Jesus, give me strength to do the things I don't like to do.



THIRD STATION

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help us to keep trying to do our best for You.

FOURTH STATION

Jesus Meets His Mother, Mary

As Jesus looked around Him, He saw and heard people cursing and laughing at Him. He also saw His mother, Mary, who could not get close enough to speak to Him. But He knew she was there and He was happy she was near to give Him strength.

When is the last time you did something for your mother? Have you ever thought of how much she has done for you? She has always been by your side when you needed her and you have always been in her heart. Jesus didn't forget His mother, Mary. When Jesus needed her, even though her sadness was great, Mary was there.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help us to be grateful for those

who love us.



FIFTH STATION

Simon Helps To Carry Jesus' Cross

As Jesus carried the cross up the hill the soldiers saw that He was very tired and weak. They did not want Him to die on the road so they pulled Simon out of the crowd and told him to help. To help a man on his way to be executed was difficult but Simon did what was needed.

Have you helped anyone lately? When you are playing games and someone falls down, you can help them up or perhaps when you go to the store with your mother you could show your love for her by carrying her packages. Can you refuse to do little things when you think of how Simon helped to carry the cross?

Prayer: Lord Jesus, make us ready and willing to help our neighbor.

SIXTH STATION

Veronica Wipes The Face Of Jesus

All during His life Jesus showed how He loved other people. He gave them food if they were hungry, sight if they were blind. While He was on His way to be crucified, a woman imitated His example and came out of the crowd to wipe His face to make Him feel better.

Making someone feel better is a good deed. A card or a visit to a sick friend is a small but kind act, especially if you took a little trouble to do it.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help us to be thoughtful in all that we do in Your name.



SEVENTH STATION

Jesus Falls The Second Time

Jesus found it very hard to get up after He fell a second time. The crowds of people pushed and pulled at Him to make Him get up and keep going. Jesus stood up and began to walk again.

Have you ever been the only person to think something was right? Being left alone to fight for your point of view is difficult. Perhaps you were laughed at and made fun of by many people. But like Jesus, you stood up for what was right.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, give me the strength to please You even when my friends refuse to do what is right.



EIGHTH STATION

Jesus Speaks To The Women And Children

The sight of Jesus with His torn clothes and bloody face made the women and children turn away and cry. Jesus did not want them to feel sorry for Him, so He told them to pray for themselves and their children who would have to suffer.

Have you ever tried to comfort a sister or brother after you both were hurt or did not get something? Even though you may have been hurt, you tried to make your brother or sister feel better. This is what Jesus did. Even though He was hurt and sad, He had enough strength and feeling to stop and speak kindly to the women and children.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help me to pay attention to the needs of others.

NINTH STATION

Jesus Falls A Third Time

As Jesus began to walk up the steep hill He fell a third time. He was so tired He could not get up again. He was very embarrassed as the people laughed at Him trying to get up again.

No one is perfect; it is human to make mistakes. But we must learn to get up and do better from our falls. Even Jesus Christ, King of Kings, fell, but He always got up again and went on.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, even when I make mistakes give me the strength to try again and again.



TENTH STATION

Jesus Is Stripped Of His Garments

At last Jesus came to the top of the hill. The soldiers took the cross from Him and tore His clothes off His body. He stood naked – ready to die on the cross.

Has a crowd of people ever made fun of you? Maybe they did not even know they were hurting you by making you feel bad in front of everybody. This is what happened to Jesus, yet He did not complain.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help me not to be afraid of what others think or say about me. Make us strong when others are weak



ELEVENTH STATION

Jesus Is Crucified

Jesus was held on the cross with large nails in His hands and feet. The soldiers left Him hanging there in the hot sun for three hours so that He would die.

Having to stay behind when someone is going fishing or to a circus is not easy. It can make us feel sad and even want to cry, but we should suffer bravely like Christ did when the soldiers drove nails into His hands and feet.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help us to put up with the hard things in our world.



TWELFTH STATION

Jesus Dies On The Cross

As He hung on the cross, Jesus forgave the soldiers and prayed for His mother and friends. He told them He did everything His Father wanted Him to do for the world. He bowed His head and died.

Sometimes people go out of their way for the good of others. Parents sacrifice because they want to give their children every good thing in life. Jesus wanted all of us to have the goodness of living with God, so He died on the cross for us.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, make us willing to work and share for You and for other people.



THIRTEENTH STATION

Jesus Is Taken Down From The Cross

After Jesus died, His friend, Joseph, took the body from the cross. Joseph was very sad as he wiped away the blood and cleaned the cuts that covered the body of Jesus. He then prepared the body for burial.

It is a very kind and loving thing to care for someone else. When we care for a friend it is easy; but we must learn to give as much care to one who doesn't like us as we would give to a friend. Then we are showing our real love for them.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, teach us to care for everyone.



FOURTEENTH STATION

Jesus Is Laid In The Tomb

Joseph took the body of Jesus and laid it in a tomb cut out of a rock. He rolled a large stone in front of the tomb and then sadly went home. Jesus was buried.

When is the last time you shared with someone? Sharing what you don't want or sharing unwillingly is not friendly or right, but when you willingly share something dear to you, you are rewarded by having more left for yourself. Joseph shared something special with Jesus. Because he loved Him so much, he gave Jesus his own tomb.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help us learn how to share with other boys and girls.



FIFTEENTH STATION

Jesus did not disappoint His friends. On Easter Sunday He came back to speak with them. He told them to be happy, for He would help them live with Him forever.
