ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a scholarship, the individual must be:

- A. A practicing Catholic and a resident of the State of Texas, **and**
- B. A graduating high school senior of the current year or enrolled in a two or four year accredited College or University taking a minimum of twelve semester hours, **and**
- C. The individual must meet **one of the following** criteria:
 - 1. Be a member in good standing of Council #9201.
 - 2. Be a child/grandchild of a member in good standing of Council #9201 or a child/grandchild of a deceased member who was in good standing with Council #9201.
 - 3. Be a child/grandchild of a registered parishioner of St. Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church.
- D. The applicant must prepare, in ink neatly, and submit the following in the time frame prescribed by the committee (no later than 5 pm, April 22, 2024):
 - 1. Completed application (including statement in 250 words or less why a scholarship is desired), and
 - 2. Official transcript from last school attended, and
 - 3. Letter(s) of recommendation (at least one but not more than three).

The completed application – pages 1, 2, 3, and 4 --(and transcript and recommendations) must be returned to the St. Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church office in a sealed envelope addressed to the Knights of Columbus #9201 Scholarship Fund by 5 pm, April 22, 2025
